AWARDS

Individual Class Awards: Each class will be awarded 1st – 6th place ribbons.

Daily High Point Awards: Ribbon and Gift or Gift Certificate. All exhibitors are eligible for Daily High Point Awards.

Daily High Point Awards are presented for the following divisions;

- Beginner 13 & Under – Walk/Trot Pile of Poles
- Open -Walk/Trot X-Rails
- Open – Walk/Trot/Canter X-Rails (18")
- Open - 2' - Walk/Trot/Canter (No Oxers)
- Open
- Amateur Adult
- Youth 14-17
- 13 & Under
- Walk/Trot – All Ages

Special daily award will be given for "Super Horse", defined by any horse shown by one or more exhibitor accumulating the most points across classes and/or divisions.

*Halter does not count towards Daily High Point but may be used as a tie-breaker.

Year End High Point Awards: Year End High Point Awards will be given as follows;

HIGH POINT BLANKET AWARDS

- Beginner 13 & Under – Walk/Trot Pile of Poles
- Open -Walk/Trot X-Rails
- Open – Walk/Trot/Canter X-Rails (18")
- Open - 2' - Walk/Trot/Canter (No Oxers)

HIGH POINT BUCKLE AWARDS

- Open
- Amateur Adult
- Youth 14-17
- 13 & Under
- Walk/Trot – All Ages

HIGH POINT RIBBON/Gift or Gift/Certificate AWARDS

- Halter – Mares
- Halter – Geldings
- Super Horse

Show Management reserves the right to split out age divisions for riders and/or horses for Year End Awards

Show managers reserve the right to split, combine (unless conflict exists with a shared horse), or cancel any classes.

Halter, Showmanship, Lead Line and Trail Classes may be shown in English or Western attire and tack.

Walk/Trot Divisions: Available for riders who are uncomfortable with cantering or loping. Riders cannot cross-enter into any other point-earning classes without forfeiting all of their Walk/Trot points, and cannot return to Walk/Trot Division until the following show series.

Walk/Trot riders are eligible to ride any age horse with a snaffle bit. This rule does not apply to Jumping Divisions.

Amateur Adult Classes: Refers to any exhibitor 18 and over who has not shown, judged, trained or assisted in training a horse for remuneration, monetary or otherwise, either directly or indirectly, nor received remuneration for instructing another person in riding, driving, training or showing a horse for three calendar years previous to registration date for current show series.

Open Classes are open to all exhibitors, including professionals.
