All exhibitors are responsible for reading and understanding the Rules and Regulations outlined herein by the management of Table Mountain Ranch, Inc. (hereafter be referred to as TMR).

Shows are open to all breeds, ages and disciplines Professionals are welcome to enter in Open and Training Tack Classes and are eligible for Daily High Point Awards and Year End High Point Awards (for Series).

All patterns will be posted at the shows. Pattern books will also be available for purchase at the registration desk.

Strollers, umbrellas and loose dogs are not allowed for the safety of those riding. NO DOGS are allowed in indoor arena or buildings. Please keep dogs, umbrellas and strollers away from outdoor arena during classes.

Apparel: ASTM/SEI Certified Helmets are recommended for all classes and required for all jumping classes. Exhibitors must wear boots with heels, long or short sleeved button down or polo style shirts and long pants. Western hats required if not showing in helmet. Hunt coat and/or chaps optional.

Coggins and Vaccination Records TMR is primarily a boarding and training facility. To protect the health of our boarded horses all exhibitors are required to bring a current copy of Coggins (taken within 1 year of event). Vaccinations must be up to date. Please provide records or proof of all vaccines given within 6 months of an event.

Dangerous, sick or unruly horses: Show managers reserve the right to ask any exhibitor unable to reasonably maintain control of their horse to forfeit a class, or the show entirely. Same rule applies for horses visibly sick or injured as determined by show management, attending veterinarian or judge. Refunds will not be given in such instances.

Stallions may only be shown in Open Classes by professional trainers or exhibitors 21 & over.

Snaffle bits: Anyone, apart from professionals may ride horses of any age in a snaffle bit in Western classes of their choice other than the Open Division. Horses under 6 years old may be shown in any class in a snaffle bit.

Exhibitor Age: will be determined as of January 1st of the current year.

Refunds: Exhibitors paying in full for any or all classes prior to showing may not receive refunds for any classes scratched. Open checks left with Secretary during registration may add or scratch classes at the Office only, not at the Gate.

Inclement Weather: No rain date will be set for make-up show due to inclement weather. Show management reserves right to move the entire show to indoor arena if necessary and Trail Classes may be rescheduled to the end of show to facilitate completing the class list.
