## **ENTRIES**

We will only accept online entries via <https://www.horseshowoffice.com/#/events> No paper entries will be accepted for this show.

Please note that under USEF rules the person responsible for the horse on the show grounds is considered the TRAINER. If your trainer/instructor comes with you to the show grounds they need to sign as COACH. If you do not own the horse, you may sign in the owner signature box as AGENT.

The following documents are required to enter and you need to upload them to Horse Show Office <https://www.horseshowoffice.com/#/events>

1. Proof of negative Coggins (dated within 12 months of show)
2. Proof of horse vaccination for equine influenza virus and equine herpes virus (dated within six months of the show)

Optional:

A copy of your 2023 RMDS Horse/Rider/Owner Card for scores to qualify for RMDS Championships and year- end awards. Riders or their representative must have a minimum of 4 recorded volunteer hours in the current competition year to be eligible for year-end awards. You can upload a copy of your card to Horse Show Office.

To qualify as an Adult Amateur you must enter your USEF number into Horse Show Office. You must be a current member of USEF to qualify as an Adult Amateur

## **FEES**

\$35 for each class. No additional divisions or cross entries. \$35 non-refundable Office Fee. No USEF drug fee, non-member fee or bridle tag deposit but \$25 fee for each change after closing date. Late entries after initial close accepted with a \$20 late fee. Non-compete horse fee \$10 plus office fee.

## **RIDE TIMES**

Riders will be notified of their tentative times by Thursday before the show. Ride times will be finalized at noon the day prior to the show. Ride times will be posted on Horse Show Office.

## **REFUNDS**

The office fee is nonrefundable. Before initial closing date, class fees minus office fee will be refunded. After initial closing day to the day before the show, refunds only for class fees if ride(s) can be filled. During competition, no refunds of any kind for any reason. No refunds due to acts of nature, including acts of God.

## **AWARDS**

Ribbons to third place. Western Dressage Association of Colorado and Western Dressage Association of America have recognized both of these shows.

## **WAITLIST**

A waitlist will be maintained after competition is filled and will be maintained until the final close.

## **REQUIRED FOR HORSES**

Proof of horse vaccination for equine influenza virus and equine herpes virus within six months of show must be included with entry. Proof of negative Coggins must be included with entry.

## **REQUIRED FOR RIDERS**

Anyone on horseback must wear protective headgear with harness secured. Amateurs must provide USEF Amateur status or else compete in the Open division.

## **SCHOOLING HORSES**

If you wish to bring your horse for schooling purposes only, you need to pay the office fee and a non-compete fee of \$10 and provide proof of negative Coggins and of vaccinations. You will receive a bridle tag and must check in at the show office. No horses are allowed to be in the warm-up without a bridle tag.

## **ARENA**

Outdoor 20 x 60-meter arena with mixed pea gravel and wood chip footing (or equivalent); warm-up in large outdoor sand arena. Round Pen only for lunging.

## **DIRECTIONS**

From the west, at stoplight turn east from Highway 93 (between Golden and Boulder) onto W 58th Avenue. Drive 0.7 miles on W 58th Avenue. Turn south on Culebra Drive (Wild Horse Ranch sign).

## **PARKING**

Parking map will be provided with ride times email. Trailers parked inappropriately will be asked to move.
