**FEES:**

\$25 for each class. No additional divisions or cross entries. \$30 non-refundable Office Fee. \$25 fee for each change after closing date. Late entries after initial close accepted with a \$20 late fee. Non-compete horse fee \$10 plus office fee.

**RIDE TIMES**

Riders will be notified of their tentative times by Thursday before the show. Ride times will be finalized at noon the day prior to the show. Ride times will be posted on Horse Show Office.

**REFUNDS:**

The office fee is nonrefundable. Before initial closing date, class fees minus office fee will be refunded. After initial closing day to day before show, refunds only for class fees if ride(s) can be filled. During competition, no refunds of any kind for any reason. No refunds due to acts of nature, including acts of God.

**AWARDS:**

Ribbons to third place. Western Dressage Association of Colorado and Western Dressage Association of America have recognized both of these shows.

**WAITLIST:**

A waitlist will be maintained after competition is filled and will be maintained until the final close.

**REQUIRED FOR HORSES:**

Proof of horse vaccination for equine influenza virus and equine herpes virus within six months of show must be included with entry. Proof of negative Coggins within 12 months must be included with entry.

**REQUIRED FOR RIDERS**

Informal dress: Helmets, long pants, and boots with heel required by anyone on horseback.

**TACK RULES:**

USEF tack rules apply for USEF dressage tests First Level and above, training tack permitted at Intro and Training Levels. WDAA tack rules apply for all WDAA tests. Cross entries between Classical and Western Dressage classes permitted.

**SCHOOLING HORSES:**

If you wish to bring your horse for schooling purposes only, you need to pay the office fee and a non-compete fee of \$10 and provide proof of negative Coggins and of vaccinations. You will receive a bridle tag and must check in at the show office. No horses are allowed to be in the warm-up without a bridle tag.

**ARENA**

Outdoor 20 x 60-meter arena (exceptions can be made for USEA classes) with mixed pea gravel and wood chip footing (or equivalent); warm-up in large outdoor sand arena. Round Pen only for lunging.

**DIRECTIONS**

From the west, at stoplight turn east from Highway 93 (between Golden and Boulder) onto West 58th Avenue. Drive 0.7 miles and turn south on Culebra Drive to enter Table Mountain Ranch. Follow directions for parking.

**PARKING**

Please follow the parking map provided with ride times email. Trailers parked inappropriately will be asked to move.
